FUNDING AND FEES

Tysoe Children's Group is operational between the hours of 7.45 am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday for 51 weeks of the year. We are not open on bank holidays and we close for one week between Christmas and the New Year.

We accept all types of government funding for children under statutory school age.

FUNDED HOURS

Universal 15 Hours funding for 3 and 4 year olds – term after the child's third birthday.

Tysoe Children's Group offer the universal 15 hours funding for 3 and 4 year old children over 38 weeks term time only.

Extended Entitlement (30 hours) and Working Parent Entitlement for children 9mths and over

Alongside the universal funding we offer the extended 15 hour entitlement for 3 and 4 year old children and the Working Parent Entitlement for children 9 months and above. We offer this funding over both term time (38 weeks of the year) **and** over 51 weeks of the year (Stretch Option) equating to fewer hours per week over 51 weeks.

Funded hours can be taken over a minimum of 2 sessions per week and for a maximum of 10 hours per day between the hours of 8am and 6pm.

Meals are not included as part of the funded offer and are an additional cost to parents.

2Help childcare funding for two-year-olds for families receiving some additional forms of government support

You may be able to access up to 15 hours funded childcare over 38 weeks for your two-year-old from the term after their second birthday if you are in receipt of certain benefits and meet the eligibility criteria. Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)

The Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) is additional funding that can be claimed by childcare providers who have eligible children receiving government funding and whom take up their full funding entitlement. This was introduced by the Government and will pay an additional £300 per financial year to early years providers for eligible 3 and 4 year old children that take up their full 15 hour entitlement. The funding follows the child and goes to all early years providers that are delivering the funded early education entitlement.

To claim for the EYPP, parents must fully complete and sign the EYPP application section on the Parent Declaration Form (PDF) given to you by your early years provider.

Disability Access Fund (DAF)

To be eligible for DAF 3 & 4 year olds must meet the following criteria:

- ❖ The child is in receipt of Disability Living Allowance (DLA) – (a copy must be given to your childcare provider) **And**
- ❖ The child receives some or all of the universal 15 hours entitlement

To claim for the Disability Access Fund (DAF) you must fully complete and sign the DAF application section on the PDF (Parent Declaration Form) given to you by your Early Years Provider.

CONSUMABLES CHARGE.

A consumables charge of £1.00 per funded hour applies. The consumables charge is applicable to each funded hour and does not apply to “paid for” hours. The consumables charge covers services which are not covered by early years funding (this is for the educational content only) for example snacks, cookery ingredients, forest school activities, suncream, nappies, wipes and nappy creams, Humming Bee Rhyme and Rhythm and our fun Mini Athletics sessions.

We understand that some families may not be able to afford the consumables charge, therefore if you experience difficulties meeting the cost of the additional services, please speak to Yvonne in confidence. If a parent chooses not to pay the consumable charge however they will be offered the opportunity to provide their own nappies, creams and snacks, etc.

OPTIONAL HOT LUNCH – We offer a nutritious 2-course hot lunch for which there is an additional charge. The cost is £3.50 per lunch, per day. We can cater to all allergies and offer a vegetarian alternative as well. The option for parents to provide a packed lunch from home is available if that is preferred however we require this to be **NUT FREE** and healthy (suggestions include a filled sandwich/roll or wrap, humous with carrot and cucumber sticks, a piece of fruit, a yogurt or similar, small packet of quavers/skips or similar, please do avoid chocolate, sweets and fizzy drinks)

REGISTRATION FEE – this applies to children who pay for some or all of their sessions: £70 non-refundable for a pre-school place. The registration fee reserves your child’s space for the agreed sessions and covers the settling-in sessions, book bag, either a child’s polo shirt or sweatshirt, and set up costs for invoicing and our nursery communication software.

If parents are accessing the government funded hours only the registration fee is not applicable, therefore £0 is payable.
